Personal Anecdote: From Frustration to Insight

During my early years as a professor, I initially resisted the 2-2 short answer scholarly article. I felt it was too restrictive, limiting students' ability to fully articulate their thoughts. I favored longer essays, believing they allowed for greater depth of analysis. However, after consistently observing students struggle with essay structure and argumentation, I decided to experiment. The results were surprising. Students, freed from the burden of lengthy essays, focused intensely on developing clear, concise arguments, leading to a significant improvement in their analytical skills. This experience profoundly shaped my understanding of the pedagogical potential of the 2-2 short answer scholarly

Case Study 1: History 101 - Analyzing Primary Sources

In a History 101 course, students were tasked with analyzing two primary source documents relevant to the American Revolution. The 2-2 short answer scholarly article format required them to address: (1) the historical context of each document and (2) its significance in understanding the broader narrative of the revolution. This format forced students to engage critically with the sources, extracting key information and weaving it into a coherent argument within the constraints of the short answer format. The results showed a marked improvement in students' ability to synthesize information and interpret historical evidence compared to previous semesters where longer essays were assigned.

Case Study 2: Literature 202 - Interpreting Literary Devices

In a Literature 202 course focusing on modern poetry, students utilized the 2-2 short answer scholarly article to analyze two poems by different authors. The questions focused on: (1) the identification and interpretation of key literary devices and (2) the impact of these devices on the overall meaning and effect of the poem. The brevity of the 2-2 short answer scholarly article forced students to prioritize their analysis, selecting the most relevant aspects of the poems to discuss.
