Once the analysis is complete, the second phase involves developing the actual business continuity plan. This includes creating detailed procedures for responding to various scenarios, identifying alternative work locations, establishing communication protocols, and outlining the roles and responsibilities of key personnel.

This stage involves:

Developing Recovery Strategies: Determining how each critical function will be recovered in the event of a disruption.

Developing Communication Plans: Establishing procedures for internal and external communication during a crisis.

Developing Training Programs: Providing employees with training on their roles and responsibilities in the BCP.
